Solve each problem.

1) Nancy purchases 2 indoor plants, each costing \$4.20. She pays with 20 dollars.

How much is her change?

$$4.20 \times 2 = 8.40$$

2) Debby purchased 4 gift cards. Each card was priced at \$2.45 and she handed over 20 dollars. What should be the amount of her change?

$$2.45 \times 4 = 9.80$$

3) Paul got 3 pet toys at the pet store. If the cost per toy is \$2.85 and he pays 20 dollars, how much change should he expect back?

$$2.85 \times 3 = 8.55$$

4) Katie attended a concert and bought 4 tickets for \$1.25 each. She handed the cashier 20 dollars. What should be her change?

$$1.25 \times 4 = 5.00$$

5) Oliver wants to buy 3 paintbrushes for his art class. The cost of each is \$2.75. If he pays with 20 dollars, what is the amount of change he should receive?

$$2.75 \times 3 = 8.25$$

6) Henry saw his favorite chips on sale for \$1.95 per bag. He decided to buy 5 bags and paid the cashier 20 dollars. Calculate his change.

$$1.95 \times 5 = 9.75$$

7) Carol is at a store to buy 4 hair accessories, priced at \$2.20. She pays with 20 dollars. How much change should she get?

$$2.20 \times 4 = 8.80$$

8) Bianca needs 4 notebooks for her classes. Each notebook is priced at \$2.25. She gives the cashier 20 dollars. Calculate her change.

$$2.25 \times 4 = 9.00$$

9) Kaleb purchased 3 soccer balls from "Bob's Sport Supplies". If each soccer ball costs \$6.60 and he gives the cashier 20 dollars, how much change is he owed?

$$6.60 \times 3 = 19.80$$

10) Lana is at a book fair, where she buys 3 books. If each book costs \$6.50, and she pays with 20 dollars, how much is her change?

$$6.50 \times 3 = 19.50$$
